30 years after graduating from UCLA (1979) – in December, 2009, I was working with *(my son)* Andrew, a Senior at Whittier Christian Senior High School, to put together his audition CD for his UCLA Freshman prescreen audition.

In January 2010, I was hand carrying the CD to Schoenberg Hall and got lost trying to find the Undergraduate Advisor's Office. I stepped into an open office to get directions, and the person standing in the office was Jennifer Judkins. Wow – she was the TA when I was in the Band, and she remembered my name!

With a notebook and CD that included pictures of Andrew playing his trombone with the Alumni Band, and a wonderful recommendation from Joel Fierberg in hand, Jennifer walked me to the Undergraduate Advisor's Office, and let me know that if



and let me know that if Andrew had any trouble getting in as a trombone player, to let her know and she would help me with a Band appeal. Andrew had great grades, wonderful

test scores, and an awesome 10-minute audition. He not only was accepted at UCLA, but he was offered a Marching Band Scholarship.

Mother and Son marched together this fall in

the Homecoming Marching Band Thriller Show with Andrew in the bright orange Tigger costume, and became one



of the first 'second generation', Mother and Son, to march in a show together in the Rose Bowl.

Andrew and his brother Matthew (trumpet) have grown up with the UCLA Alumni Band, and have been at the football games since they were infants. Andrew first played his
